Response To: "Can I see my son today"

Pattern: Harassment as response to visitation request

Legal Significance: Character assassination

Impact: Public humiliation and alienation

PUBLIC DISPARAGEMENT PATTERN

Posts:

• Pattern of public disparagement

• Creating negative narrative about father

Legal Significance: Parental alienation via social media

Impact: Public character assassination

INSTAGRAM STORIES

Bates Number: BW-SOC-005

Content: Referenced in text messages

Method: Used to communicate instead of co-parenting

Legal Significance: Public platform for private matters

Impact: Escalating conflict publicly

LEGAL ANALYSIS

HARASSMENT PATTERN

Frequency: Multiple platforms

Method: Public disparagement

Target: Tyler's character and reputation

Impact: Creates hostile environment

PARENTAL ALIENATION

Method: Public character assassination

Goal: Damage father-child relationship **Impact:** Teaching child to reject father

Pattern: Systematic disparagement

PUBLIC DISPARAGEMENT

Platforms: Snapchat, Facebook, Instagram

Content: Hostile and degrading

Timing: During visitation denial period

Impact: Escalates conflict publicly

EVIDENCE STRENGTH

SNAPCHAT HARASSMENT: 8/10

Strengths:

- Clear hostile language
- Timing with visitation denial
- Pattern of harassment
- Direct evidence

Weaknesses:

- Could argue private communication
- Context may be disputed

FACEBOOK DISPARAGEMENT: 7/10

Strengths:

- Public platform
- Pattern of posts
- Character assassination
- Parental alienation

Weaknesses:

- Could argue general posts
- Not explicitly naming Tyler

OVERALL SOCIAL MEDIA: 8/10

Combined Impact:

• Pattern of public disparagement

- Harassment during conflict
- Parental alienation evidence
- Character assassination

STRATEGIC USE

COURT PRESENTATION

Method: Screenshots with timestamps

Focus: Pattern of harassment

Impact: Demonstrates hostile behaviorGoal: Support custody modification

DISCOVERY REQUESTS

Platforms: All social media accounts

Time Period: July 2025 to present

Content: All posts and messages

Purpose: Complete pattern documentation

EVIDENCE PRESERVATION

Method: Screenshots with metadata

Storage: Multiple secure locations

Authentication: Timestamp verification

Chain of Custody: Documented preservation

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

IMMEDIATE (1-2 weeks)

- **Screenshot All Posts** Preserve evidence
- **Document Timestamps** Verify timing
- **Save Metadata** Authentication purposes
- **Create Timeline** Pattern documentation

SHORT-TERM (1 month)

- **Request Social Media Discovery** Complete access
- **Prepare Evidence Package** Court-ready format
- **Document Pattern** Harassment timeline

- **Update Pattern Documentation** Ongoing harassment
